We are looking for young Aboriginal people between the ages of 15 - 18 years from Taree, Forster and Karuah. Applications are available from your school or on our website. You don't need to be a good dancer to attend, just have an interest in dance, want to learn more about your culture and are committed to attend the whole camp and perform at both events. Places are limited. Only 30 students will be selected and applications close Friday June 6.
